Additional Dress Code Requirements:

- Lighter colored suits are preferred. When wearing a black or darker jacket, a lighter color top, or top and tie must be worn.
- Suits must be well-fitted, clean, and pressed.
- Tops must be clean and pressed. Plain white undershirts or camisoles need to be worn under light color dress shirts or blouses.
- Sleeveless blouses are acceptable as long as a jacket is worn.
- V-neck sweaters are acceptable as long as a jacket can be worn over the sweater and, if wearing a tie, it can be clearly seen.
- Belts must always be worn.
- Cleanly shaven is preferred. Facial hair must be kept neat, short and professional.
- An appropriate amount of makeup must be worn. Nail polish, if worn, must be professional and conservative in color.

Additional Dress Code Requirements:

- Suits must be well fitted. Baggy pants, jackets, or shirts are unacceptable.
- Tattoos must be concealed at all times in the presence of students.
- For people identifying as male, piercings of any kind are not permitted.
- For people identifying as female, only one piercing per earlobe is permitted. Earrings should be neat and traditional. Dangling earrings are unacceptable.

Additional Dress Code Requirements:

- Shoes must be clean and polished.
- Dress socks must be worn. Athletic socks, no-show socks and quarter socks are not acceptable.
- Nylons or tights must be worn with pants and skirts.
